YOU GO!

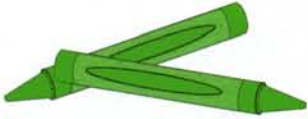

Draw a line from each person to their ride.



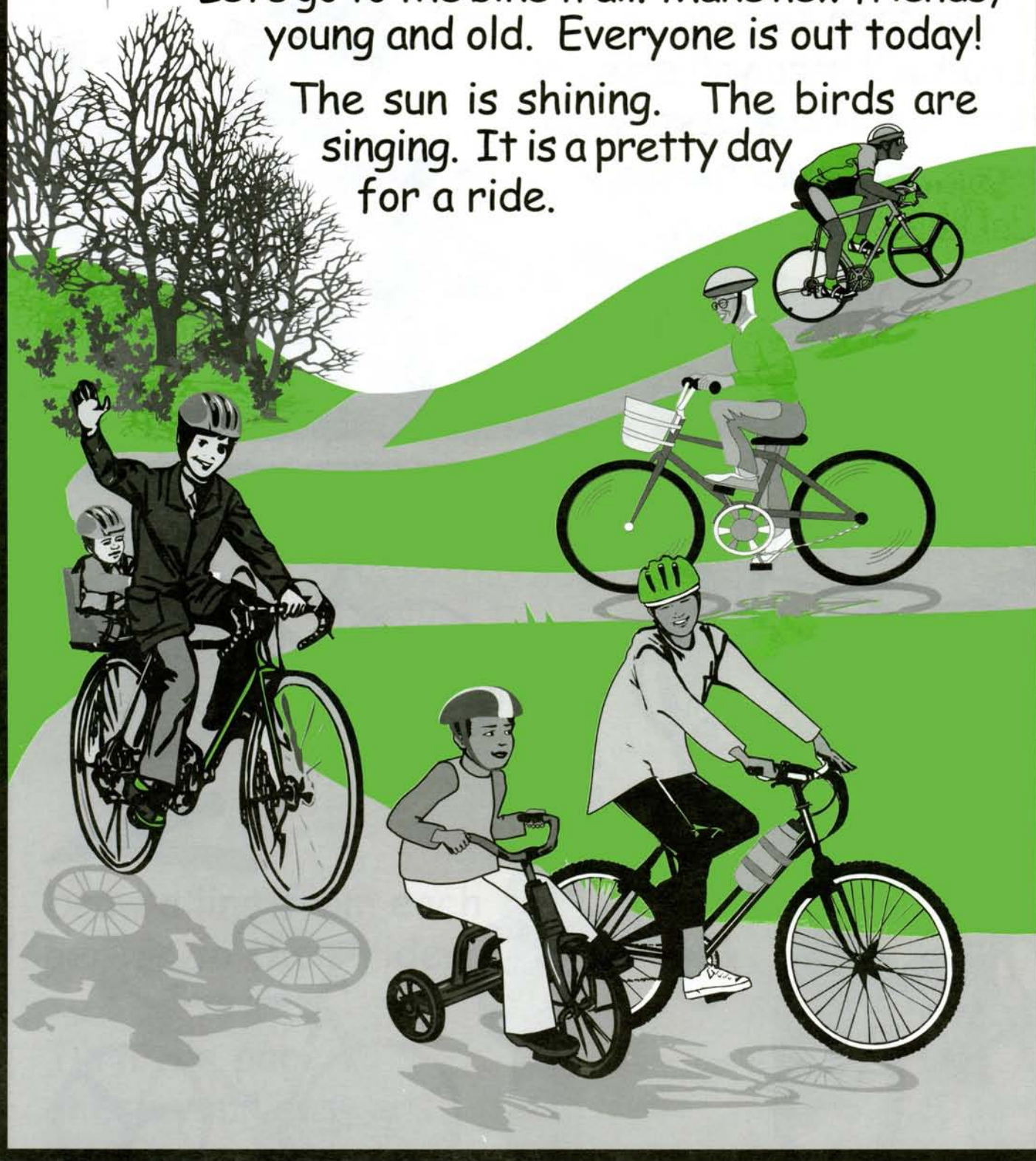
