your raindrops

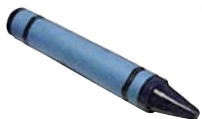

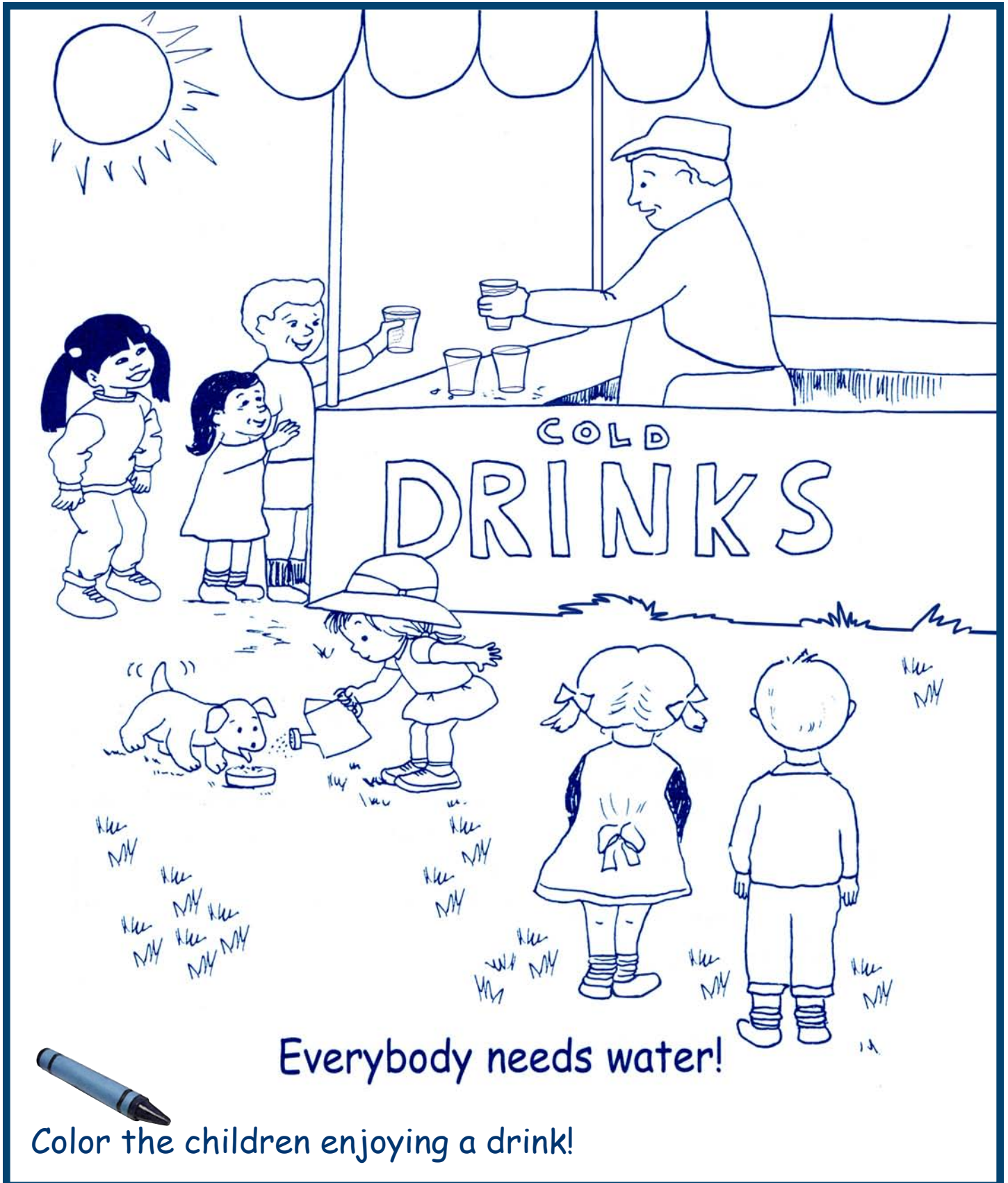

I need to drink lots of water to keep my body healthy.

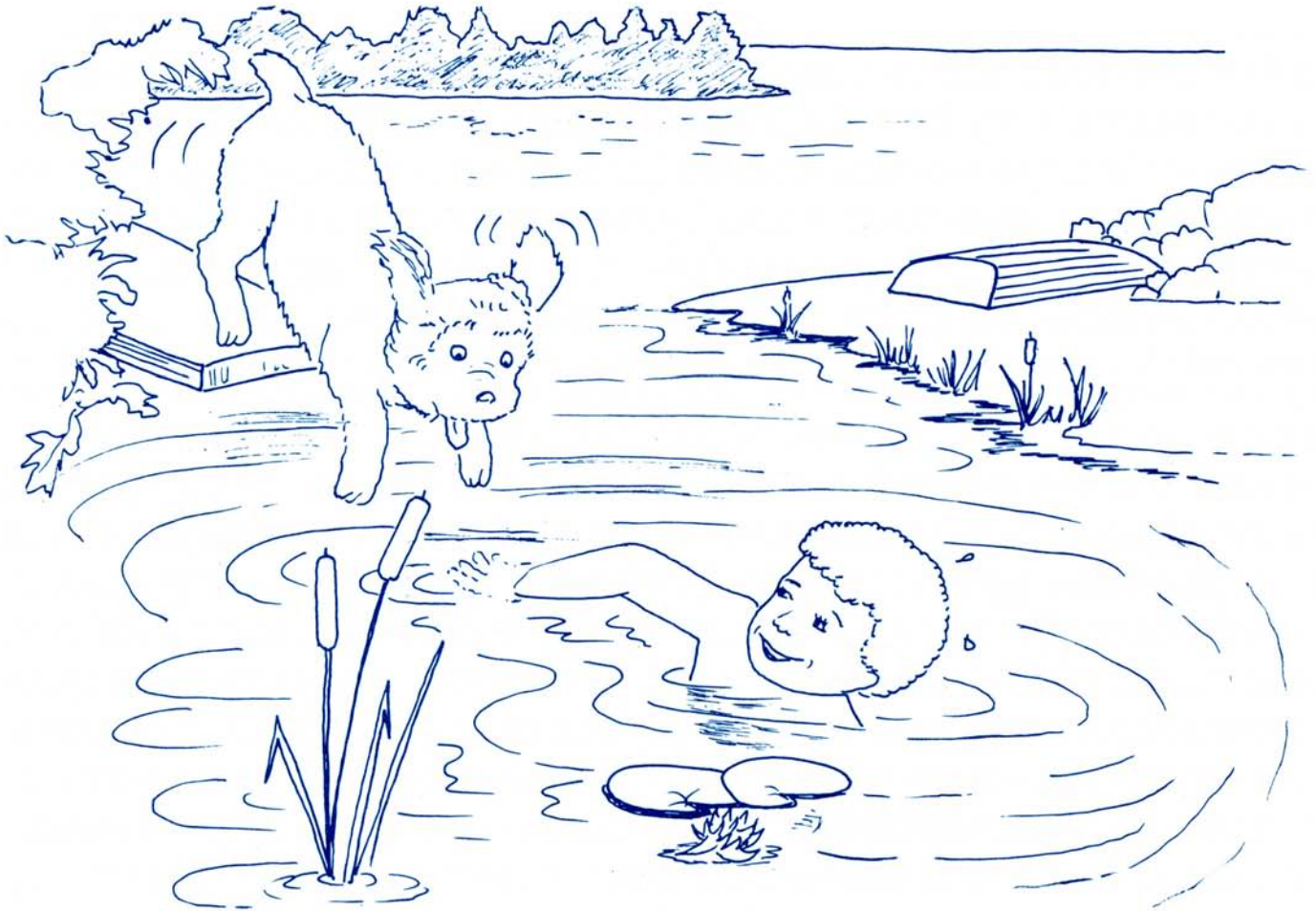


Everybody needs water!
